Award

- The Krembil post-doctoral & clinical research fellowship award is a one (1) year non-renewable \$30,000 award to support new or existing fellows who have completed a PhD or MD program and are actively engaged in research

Eligibility

- The trainee is currently or will be (by January 3, 2017) supervised by a Krembil-appointed Scientist, Senior Scientist or Clinician Investigator.
- The trainee has not received a salary support award from another source (i.e. granting agency, university award) for the proposed fellowship term and has previously not received a TWRI or Krembil Fellowship Award.
- The trainee is within four (4) years of completing a PhD or five (5) years of completing an MD program (inclusive of residency training).
- The trainee is within three (3) years of his/her postdoctoral or clinical research fellowship term at UHN

Evaluation Criteria

- Academic excellence of the candidate
- Significance and quality of the project and its alignment with Krembil goals and scope
- Collaboration between Krembil Divisions or groups, and between basic and clinical research
- Supervisor's research and training accomplishments (i.e. publications, grants, number of trainees supervised)
- No more than one (1) application per Krembil Investigator will be awarded per competition

Submission Checklist

- CV of the supervisor (truncated to include: biographical information, grant support, number of trainees supervised (undergrad, graduate and post doc) and a list of selected publication from the last five years)
- One copy of applicant's academic transcript (only graduate program transcripts are required)
